



Smiley Wristband



Finished length: 7"

Materials needed:

DMC Floss:

- 1 Skein of Lemon (#307)
- 1 Skein of Kelly Green (#702)
- 1 Skein of Dark Plum (#915)
- 1 Skein of Black (#310)
- 1 **Large** smiley-face button (approx. 1/2")

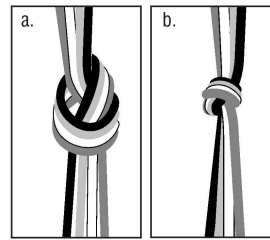
You will also need scissors, a ruler, masking tape and a piece of heavy thread or dental floss.

To make your wristband:

(Before beginning, see drawings of Overhand Knot, Weaving and Easy Bead Threading which are used on this project.)

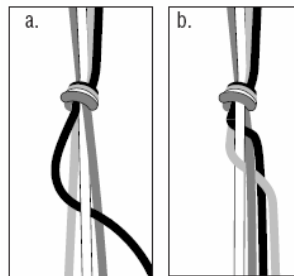
1. Cut a 42" piece of floss from each of the colors listed. Line up the ends of all strands, fold floss in half and tie an overhand knot 2" from looped end. Tape the loop to the table. Separate the colors so you have four groups of two strands (pairs).
2. Beginning with the left pair, weave over and under the other pairs. Repeat with the next pair on the left. Continue weaving until your bracelet is 3-1/2" long.
3. Thread two pairs of center strands through smiley-face button.
4. Continue weaving until your bracelet measures 7".
5. Neatly trim both ends of the wristband leaving 2" at each end.

Over Hand Knot



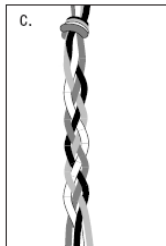
Finished Overhand Knot

Weaving



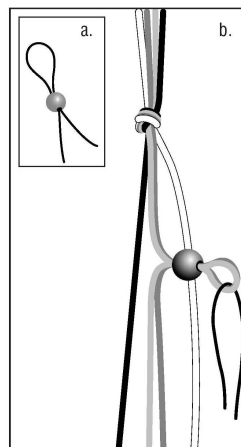
Step a. Weave the left strand over the second strand, under third strand, and over the fourth strand. Pull up snugly.

Step b. Repeat to weave with the new left strand. Pull up snugly.



Several Woven Strands

Easy Bead Threading



Step a. Use a 6" length of heavy thread or dental floss, fold in half and thread the cut ends through a bead, leaving a 2" loop on one side of the bead.

Step b. Place the filler cords through the thread loop and pull loop and floss through the bead hole.
