



Loop Flower Bracelet



Finished length: 61/2"

Materials needed:

DMC Floss:

- 1 Skein of Very Dark Lavender (#208)
- 1 Skein of Bright Christmas Green (#700)
- 1 Skein of Bright Chartreuse (#704)

You will also need scissors, a ruler, masking tape and a piece of heavy thread or dental floss.

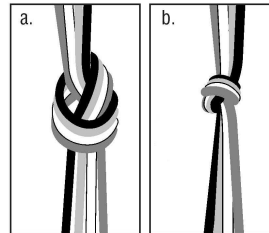
To make your bracelet:

(Before beginning, see drawings of Overhand Knot, Square Knot, Half Square Knot, and Picot Knot that are used on this project.)

1. Cut two 60" pieces of Very Dark Lavender. Cut a 60" piece and 15" piece of each Bright Christmas Green and Bright Chartreuse floss. Line up the ends of all floss pieces and tie an overhand knot 2" from end. Tape the knot to the table.
2. Separate and place the long Bright Christmas Green and Bright Chartreuse strands on one side of the shorter filler cords and Very Dark Lavender strands on the other side.
3. Tie a square knot and half square knot over the short strands (filler cords).

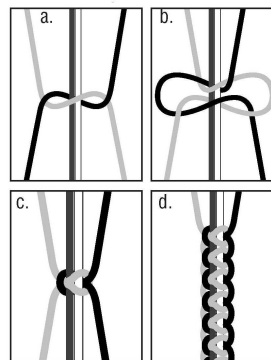
4. Using the same two strands, tie a square knot and half square knot 1/2" below last half square knot and then slide it up on filler cords forming loops on each side (picot knot).
5. Repeat Step 4 until the bracelet is 6-1/2" long.
6. To end, using all strands, tie an overhand knot. Neatly trim both ends of the bracelet leaving 2" on each end to tie around your wrist.

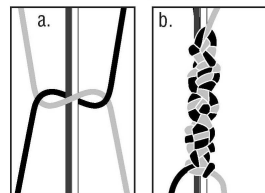

Multiple Square Knots

Step a. Lay left strand across filler cords and under right strand. Then put the right strand under filler cords and up through the loop made by left strand. Pull snugly.
Step b. Lay right strand across filler cords and under left strand. Then put the left strand under filler cords and up through the loop made by right strand. Pull snugly.

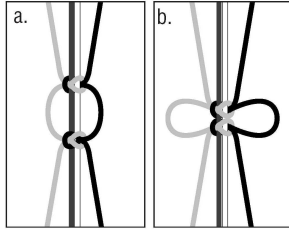
Half Square Knot



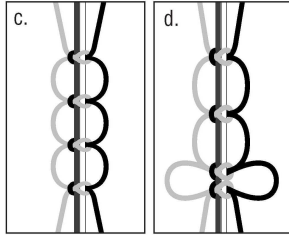
Multiple Half Square Knots

Step a. Lay left strand across filler cords and under right strand. Then put the right strand under filler cords and up through the loop made by left strand. Pull snugly.
Step b. A series of half square knots form a spiral shape.

Picot Knot



Step a. Make 1 square knot.
Make second square knot 1/2" below the previous knot.
Step b. Then slide it up on the filler cords until it touches the previous knot forming loops on each side.
