



## ***Snowflake Napkin and Runner Set***

This super simple embroidered embellishment was done on a pre-made set of burgundy napkins and matching table runner. The napkins and runner are a poly/cotton blend fabric for easy care, and can be purchased at a department or specialty home store. DMC Pearl Cotton and Needles can be purchased at any craft or needlework store.

### **Materials Needed for this Project:**

- Set of four napkins and coordinating table runner of your choice
- DMC Pearl Cotton (Size 5) skeins
  - Color 677 Very Light Old Gold – 2 skeins (use for diamond shapes in center of snowflake)
  - Color 712 Cream – 1 skein (use for all other outer parts of snowflake)
  - Color 815 Medium Garnet – 2 skeins (use to make tassels)
- DMC Chenille Needle, Size 22
- “Snowflake” design (see below for downloading)

### **Instructions:**

1. Use tracing paper to transfer the designs from the following page onto your napkins and runner. It is your choice as to the exact positioning of the snowflakes.
2. Use Pearl Cotton with the Back Stitch to cover the traced lines of the Snowflake design. Pearl Cotton is a non-divisible thread that is used exactly as it comes off the skein.
3. For tassels, wrap Pearl Cotton around a 4” piece of cardboard until desired thickness is achieved. Remove from cardboard and wrap Pearl Cotton around wound thread several times, approx. ¾” from top. Cut opposite end to create loose ends. Trim to desired length. Use a strand of Pearl Cotton to sew tassel to point of runner.
